



2026-2027 Electronic Use Policy and Family Agreement

Acceptable Use

Except with teacher permission and supervision, students are not allowed to use mobile phones, laptops, or other electronic devices at school, at school events, or on school outings. When permitted, electronic devices must be used for educational purposes. School computers and emails should always be used only for educational purposes. If a student is uncertain about whether a particular use is acceptable or appropriate, they should consult a supervising adult. Each user is responsible for following the rules of etiquette and safety. Electronic devices used at school without authorization will be confiscated and returned to a parent/guardian. Repeated or serious misuse may result in additional follow-up consistent with the response framework described in the Family Handbook.

Student Emails

Students will be given their own Crowden email account. Through this account, students will have access to Google Workspace, and be able to share documents within the Crowden domain. Student emails should only be used for school. Please note that:

- Students cannot receive email from anyone outside of the @crowden.org domain. Likewise, students cannot email anyone outside of the @crowden.org domain and student email cannot be forwarded to non-school accounts.
- **Students' accounts will be suspended after the end of the academic term. If you wish to save a document long term, it should be downloaded to your personal computer.**

Rules for Etiquette and Safety

- Be polite. When sending emails, texts, comments, or media, refrain from using abusive, obscene, or threatening tone or intent.
- Be cautious. Do not reveal personal information including your full name, home address, phone numbers, or passwords; this also applies to the personal information of others. Students must not share passwords with peers or other unauthorized individuals. Parents/guardians may retain access to school-managed student accounts as described in the Family Handbook, and authorized school personnel may access or reset accounts as needed to administer them.
- Be secure. Sign out of all accounts before closing programs or shutting down. Multiple users increase the chance of security issues. Notify an adult immediately if you notice a problem or suspect a breach.

The following uses are unacceptable and may result in responses consistent with the Crowden Family Handbook:

- Unauthorized use of cell phones or other electronic devices during school.
- Use of profane, abusive, threatening, or harassing statements.
- Deleting, copying, modifying, or forging other users' names, emails, files, or data.
- Damaging, deleting, or modifying computer equipment, files, or data.
- Intentionally accessing or downloading computer viruses or other harmful files or programs.
